Most of the families they work with are Somali Bantu.

The art activity shown here encouraged participants to decorate bags showing activities they enjoy. Program planners used this information to develop reading and writing activities. Other aspects of the program included a mock restaurant that the students ran, and game development based on books that the group read together.



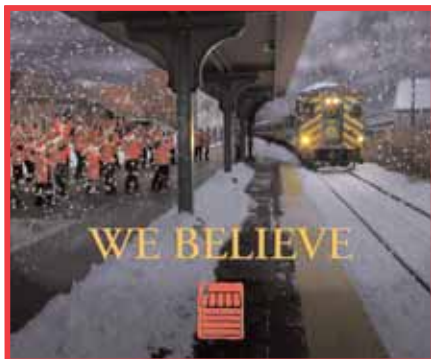

Congratulations to Amy Hornblas, Youth Services Coordinator for Aid to Women, Men, and Children in Abuse and Rape Emergencies (AWARE) in Hardwick, Vermont. Amy won a Silver Award in the Print Division of the International Safety Media Awards for her book, *This Is Your Brain on Television*.

The book explains the historical context in which our brains digest input from the screen, reveals the cultural context surrounding TV in the United States, and encourages readers to look for, promote, and create programming with healthier role models. It is easy-to-read, imaginatively illustrated and is ideal for children, parents, and teachers.
